DEFENDING AMERICA IN THE WAR ON TERROR

- ✓ Created the Department of Homeland Security, bringing government agencies together to improve intelligence gathering and prevent terrorists from entering America under false I.D.

- ✗ Opposes parental notification for a minor daughter's abortion.
